

Minutes for Phone HP Core Group Phone Conference - 21 Nov 10

ASSESSMENT PROCESS

Natalie questioned some of the wording for parts of the Assessment Document – Myffie to reword for simplicity. Natalie noted the technical aspects of the assessment information looked very complicated and perhaps could be sent later with the Assessment pack.

Payment to the Assessor/s was discussed: Myffie proposed that 2 assessors at an hour each would result in a potential charge of \$100 to the applicant. The need for 2 assessors at the Relaxation level was discussed and it was agreed that only 1 assessor would be required for the Relaxation level with 2 assessors for the Integrative level. Trainee assessors would not receive payment. It was also agreed that the applicant fee for Relaxation level would be \$50 with the Guild subsidising an optional top-up to a maximum amount of \$50.

The grandfathering in of current full members was discussed. All current full members need to be informed that they will be grandfathered into the new Relaxation level and this will require them to start doing an APC in order to remain a full member at the Relaxation level. If they do not proceed with the APC process they will be dropped into the Associate level and will need to go through the Assessment process if they wish to rejoin the Relaxation level at a later date.

It was noted that this will increase the number of APCs to be processed in Jan/Feb 2012. Further discussion to be held on this subject. It was also noted that the Guild needs to be prepared for the grandfathered Relaxation members to begin requesting Assessment for Integrative level sooner than expected.

ASSESSORS

A discussion of current APC holder as potential assessors was held. Peta Joyce and Barbara Langton were excluded due to their respective roles as Assessor Moderator and APC assessor. It was agreed to approach the following people: Barbara Gibb, Corinne Murray, Natalie Wilmer, Myffie James, Bev Makatea, John Massey and Bobbie-Joe Wilson. Natalie Wilmer has agreed to act as Assessor for the 2 current applications (with much assistance and guidance from Peta), Barbara Gibb to be approached for the same task. Yay for Natalie (and hopefully Barbara too!!). Natalie to contact Peta, Myffie to post up the assessments – hopefully to be assessed prior to Christmas.

Peta to run an Assessors training at the next Professional Development Weekend – Friday 3pm.

The APC and Minnie Mouse have been sent out.

FUTURE OF HP
